

## **Feedback Analysis Report**

**(2021-22)**

Every year, the College collects feedback from various stakeholders to measure the impact of all the efforts taken by the institution and to improve quality in all aspects. The College maintains an Institution Level Feedback Report. Feedback on curriculum and infrastructure is collected in a specific format from students, alumni, employers, and teaching faculty. The results are formulated by statistically quantifying the received feedback forms. Data collected is consolidated and a report is prepared. Data entered in the feedback forms is analysed and suggestions/feedback given by the stakeholders is given due attention.

## Student Feedback

To strengthen the quality of education, regular feedback is collected from students. They actively participate in this process and give their feedback on courses, syllabi and subject evaluation.

The Feedback Performa was analyzed and it was found that majority of students were satisfied with the current curriculum and students advocated that the current curriculum is adequate to meet their requirements.

Students admitted that teachers freely use diverse teaching methods to clarify concepts. They strongly agreed with the view that teachers motivate student's participation in the class and the teacher quickly responds to the queries of the classroom.

Almost 87.2% of the students advocated that study material related to curriculum is available in the library. Only 2% students strongly think that the curriculum did not meet our expectations.

Overall the curriculum is helpful to generate interest among students for pursuing higher studies. Students were completely satisfied with the internal assessment system.

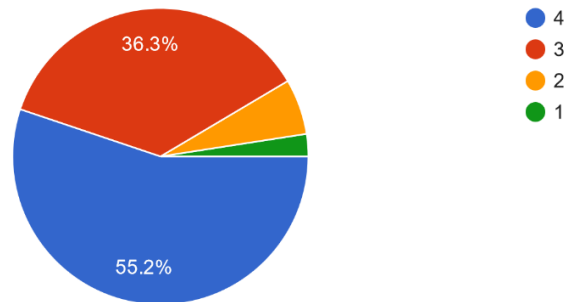

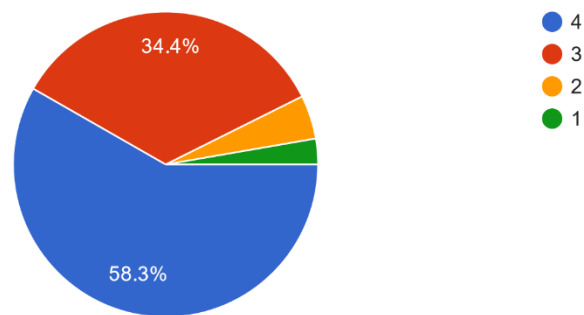
Q1 Is curriculum adequate to meet the requirements of the students?

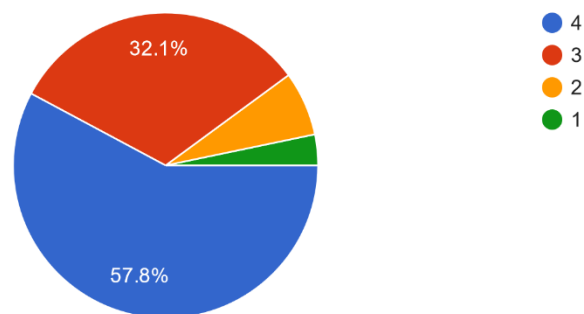
Q2 Does the teacher get fair time to complete the curriculum?

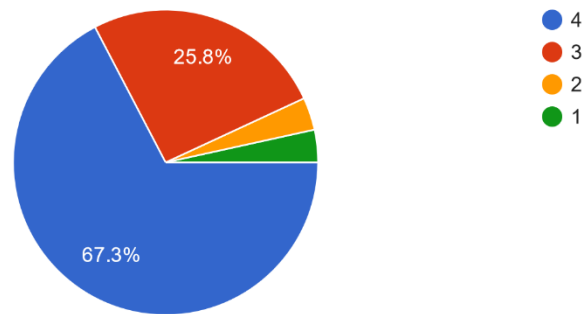
Q3 Are teachers free to use diverse teaching methods to clarify concepts?

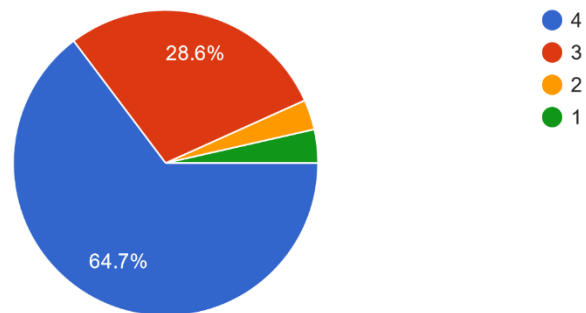
Q4 Does the teacher motivate student's participation in the class?

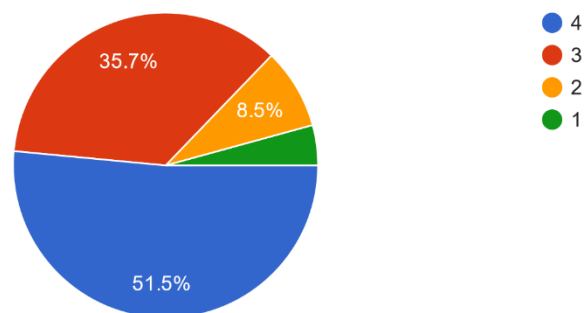
Q5 Are the teachers responsive to student queries?

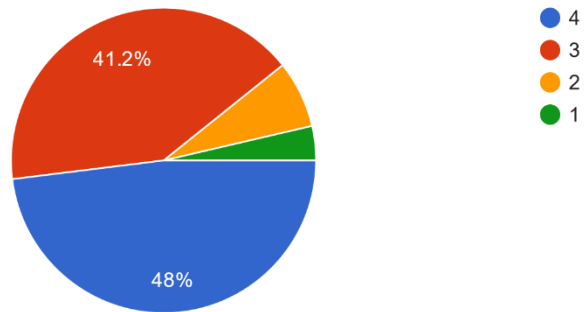
Q6 Is study material related to the curriculum available in the library?

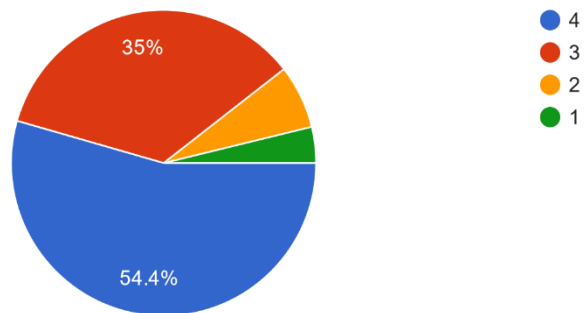
Q7 Does curriculum fulfill students ' expectations?

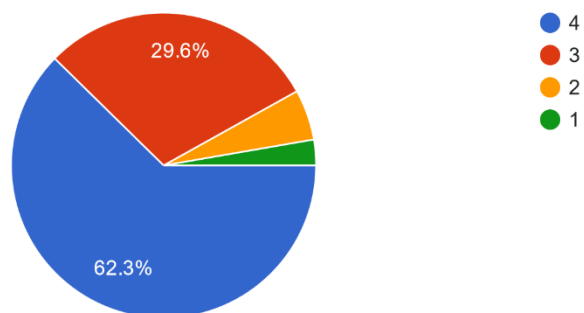
Q8 Does the curriculum generate interest in students to pursue higher studies?

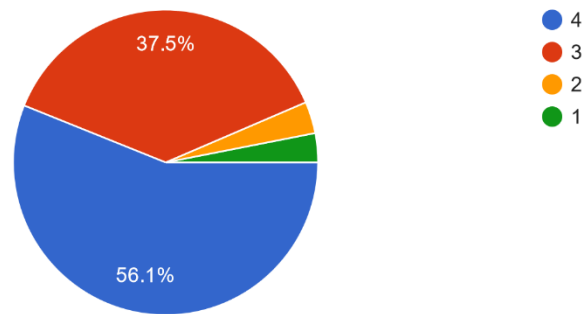
Q9 Is internal assessment process fair and impartial?

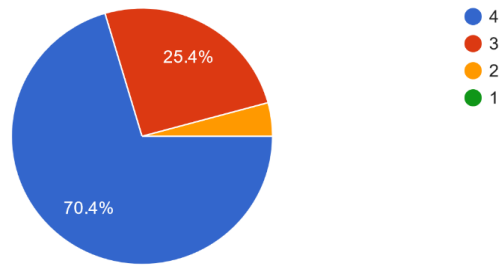

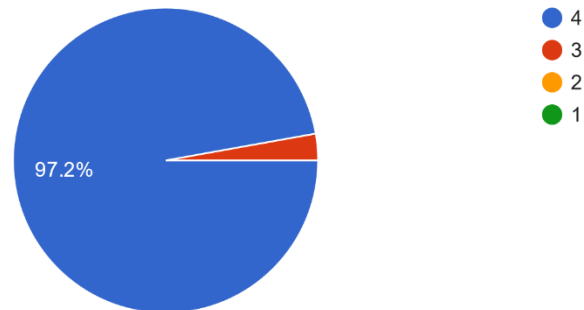
Q1 Is the current curriculum suitable for the course being taught?

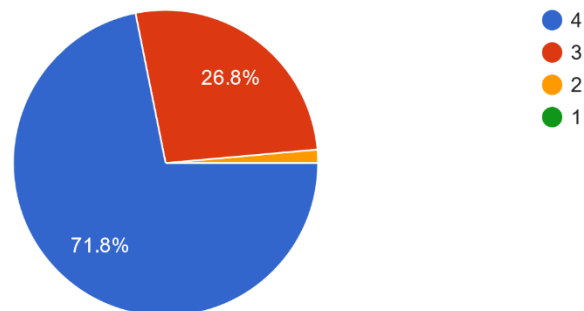
Q2 Are you able to complete the curriculum in the given time?

Q3 Are the aims and objectives of the curriculum well-defined and relevant?

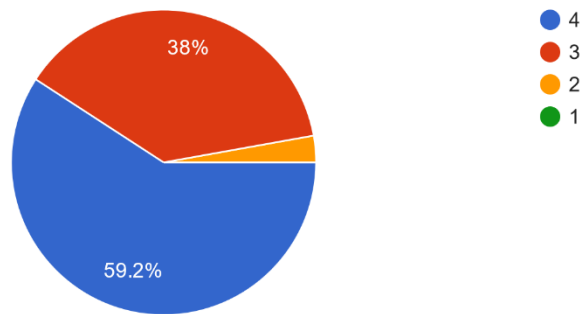

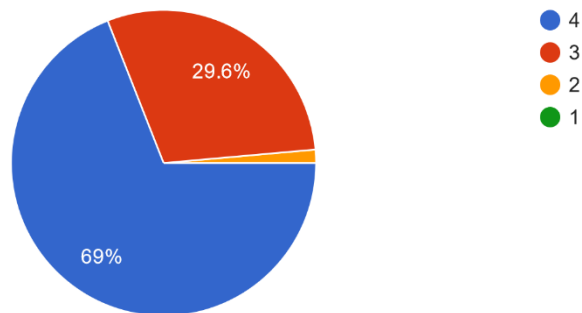
Q4 Does the course curriculum has good balance between theory and application?

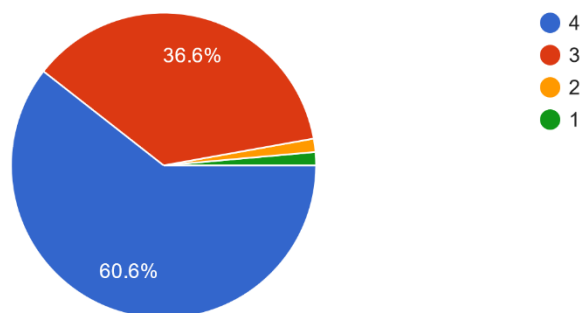
Q5 Does the curriculum create interest and involvement of the students in the class?

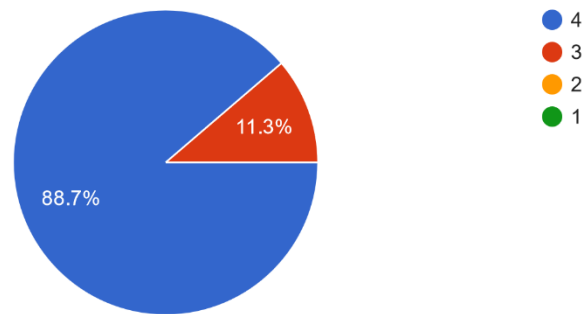
Q6 Are the books and journals prescribed by the curriculum relevant?

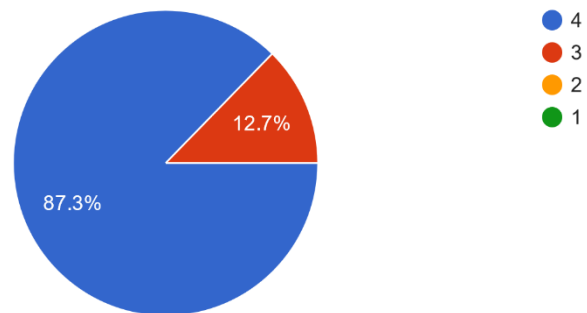
Q7 Are you taking enough steps to assist the slow learners?

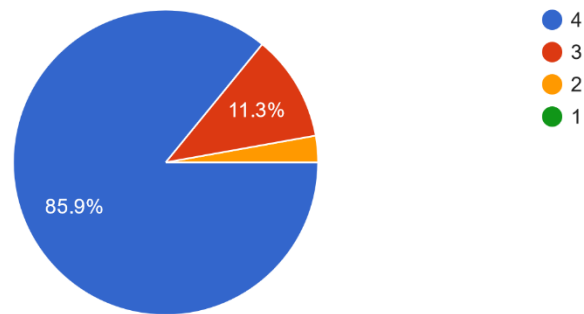
Q8 Does the sufficient study material regarding curriculum available in the library?

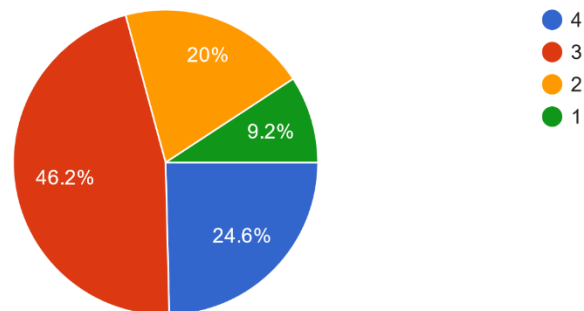
Q9 Do you have freedom to adopt new teaching methods?

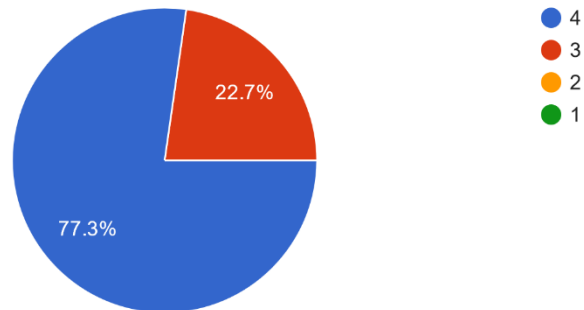

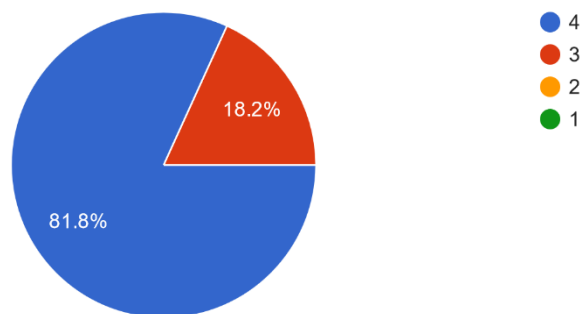
Q1 The curriculum promotes work skills

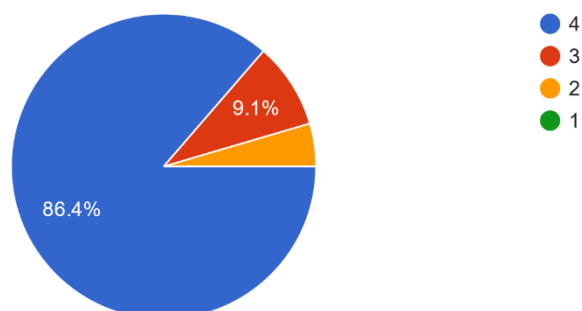
Q2 The curriculum provides sufficient knowledge in the area of employment

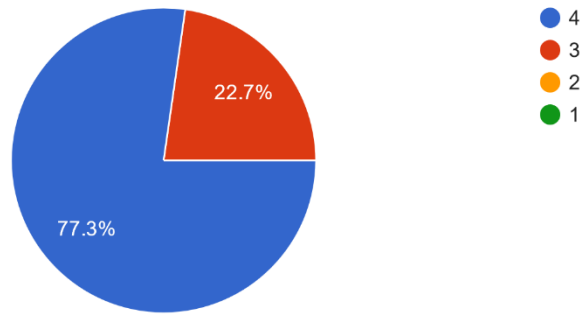
Q3 The curriculum motivates the students to work together as a team

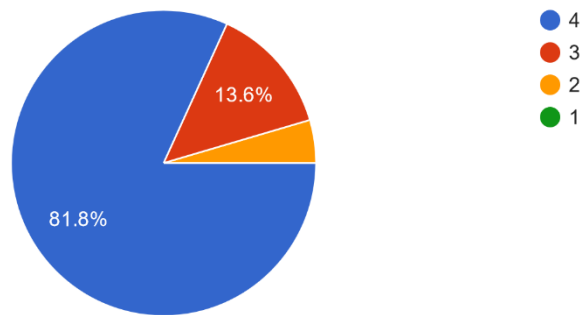
Q4 The curriculum encourages the students to apply what they have learnt

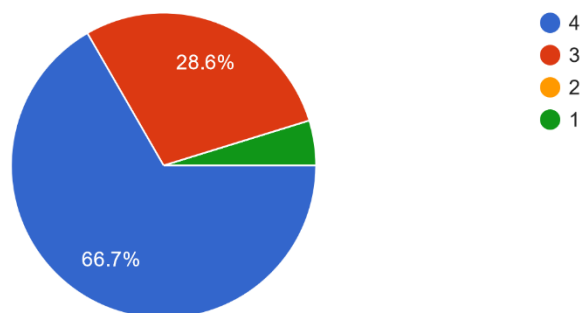
Q5 The curriculum helps the students to develop good communication skills

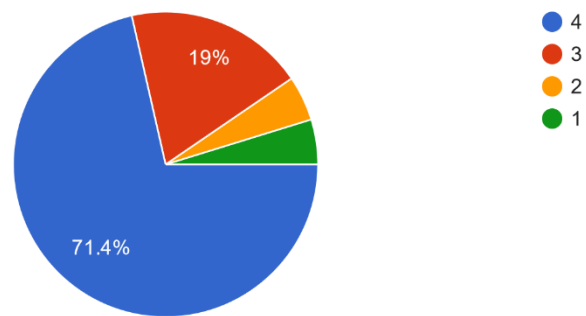
Q6 The curriculum helps the students to attain good managerial skills

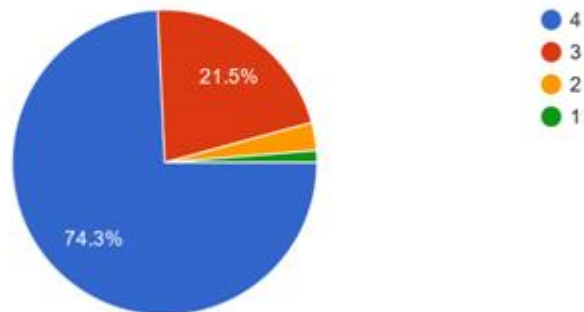

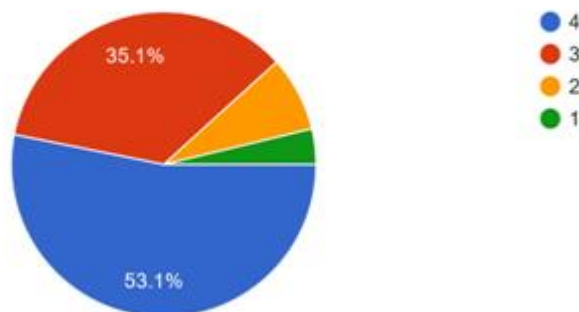
Q1 The content of the curriculum was appropriate to pursue higher education

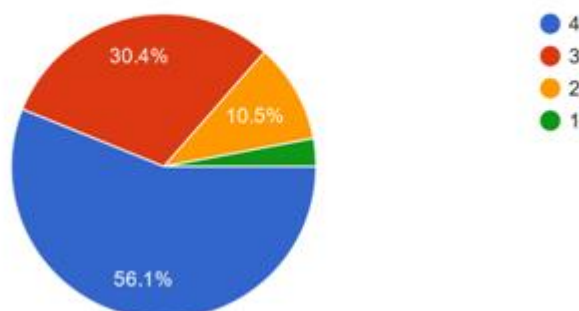
Q2 Extra mural activities in the college helped me to shape my career

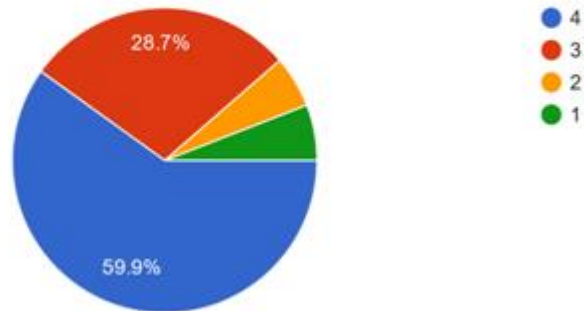
Q3 Assignments, Project work and internship helped me to develop soft skills

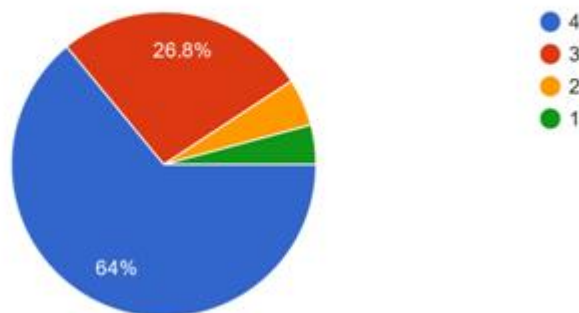
Q4 The curriculum was good enough to help me in the placement

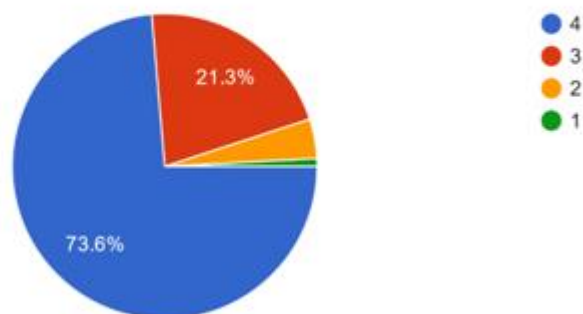
Q6 The curriculum was helpful to provide guidance and counseling
